COUNCIL MEETING
February 22, 2024

COUNCIL PRESENT: Mayor Pro Tem Mickey McGraw, Jeff Wilson, Don Harris, Becky McWhorter, and Dustin Rosser. Mayor Lanny Thomas was not present.

VISITORS PRESENT: Nicole Rosser, Justin Lowe, Brandon Croy, David Gilleland, and Missy Duncan.

Mayor Pro Tem opened the meeting with prayer. Then, Don Harris led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Pro Tem McGraw asked that the Agenda, January Minutes, and December Financial Reports be approved by general consent. Passed unanimously.

Old Business:

Mayor Pro Tem McGraw advised that we had no old business.

New Business:

Street Department: Replace contract and part-time work force with a full-time employee.

Mayor Pro Tem McGraw advised we would like to replace contract and part-time summer help with a full-time employee. Don Harris made a motion to approve this employee change. This motion received a second from Dustin Rosser. Passed unanimously.

Public Safety: Amend the Code Enforcer's Contract work from one day a week to two days a week and increase \$1,000 per month. If approved, approve the Code Enforcement Job Description.

Mayor Pro Tem McGraw advised this would amend the code enforcers contract work from one day a week to two days a week with an increase of \$1,000 per month. If we approve the increase, we need to approve the Code Enforcement Job Descriptions. After much discussion, Jeff Wilson made a motion to accept and approve both the increase in hours and pay along with the job description with a second from Don Harris. Passed unanimously.
