COUNCIL MEETING
February 27, 2025

COUNCIL PRESENT: Mayor Lanny Thomas, Jeff Wilson, Don Harris, Dustin Rosser, Mickey McGraw, and Becky McWhorter.

Mayor Thomas opened the meeting, and Mickey McGraw said the prayer. Then, Don Harris led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Thomas asked that the Agenda, January Minutes, and December Financial Reports be approved by general consent. Passed unanimously.

New Business:

Gas Department – Council Approval of new hires Jacob Spraggins & Timothy Schrader:

Mayor Thomas let Mike Hughes introduce Jacob Spraggins to everyone as the new hire he would like to replace one of his employees that left the gas department. Mike Hughes advised that Timothy Schrader was unable to attend because of sickness. Don Harris made a motion with a second from Mickey McGraw to approve Jacob Spraggins as a new hire for the Town of Trion, Gas Department. Passed unanimously.

GICH Letter – Mayor seeks permission to sign a letter of support to develop Chattooga Ridge:

This project would consist of around 52 units of affordable housing. Jeff Wilson made a motion with a second from Don Harris to give the mayor permission to sign the letter of support. Passed unanimously.

Executive Session – For the purpose of Real Estate, Personnel, and Legal Matters:

At 6:10 p.m., Dustin Rosser made a motion to go into Executive Session with a second from Don Harris. Passed unanimously.

At 6:56 p.m., Becky McWhorter made a motion to come out of Executive Session with a second from Mickey McGraw. Passed unanimously.

Mickey McGraw made a motion to authorize the payment of \$250,000.00 to plaintiff in the matter of Earl Parris, Jr vs Mount Vernon Mills, 3M Company, Town of Trion, and others, Case #4:21-cv-00040-TWT, now pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Rome Division, to resolve all pending claims in said matter against the Town, and further authorize the mayor to take any needed action on behalf of Town to accomplish the settlement. Don Harris gave this motion a second. Passed unanimously.

Council and Mayor Comments:

Jeff Wilson – The Gazebo looks good, and I see we have power to it for light and fan.

Becky McWhorter – I am excited for Hurley Park. Maybe we can get John Turner to do a friendship park. The Flag Box at the Veterans Memorial is going to be a huge asset to the community.
