Precautions & Procedures

To help limit the potential exposure of COVID-19 and other illnesses, we are reminding ALL employees and citizens to:

WASH YOUR HANDS...

with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds. Use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.

AVOID TOUCHING...

your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

AVOID CLOSE CONTACT...

With people who are sick.

COVER YOUR NOSE AND MOUTH...

with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow. Immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available, clean your hands with a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

CLEAN AND DISINFECT...

frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.

CALL YOUR HEALTHCARE PROVIDER IF...

You feel sick with fever, coughing or trouble breathing. You have been in close contact with a person known to have COVID-19. You have recently traveled from an area with ongoing spread of COVID-19

DO NOT GO TO THE DOCTOR'S OFFICE...

Avoid going to your doctor's office, the emergency room and the Health Department without calling first. Your healthcare provider will have special instructions regarding how they can assist you.
